L MARKERS create a visible framework for the ARCHIVES OF THE FUTURE






OUTLINE OF A DEVICE TO CONTAIN THE RADIOACTIVE WAVE ON THE SITE







Buried Pathways, concept for French High-Level Radioactive waste Laboratory in Bure.


Colors of Danger, concept for a Belgian High-Level Radioactive waste Laboratory








Defensive Angles, concept for the WIPP Laboratory, New Mexico desert, USA.



Sketches of BÂT/LAB made in the USA after visiting WIPP (New Mexico) and Yucca Mountain (Nevada), 2013




Metallic Defensive Cones, concept for a Spanish High-Level Radioactive waste Laboratory
